



# Where to stay on the Ile d'Oléron? our 6 best accommodations

Looking for a place to stay during your stay on the Ile d'Oléron? Below we've listed the **different types of accommodation** available on the island, as well as our **favorite villages** to stay in and easily visit on this magnificent island.

We also present our **best addresses for hotels, camping sites** and **vacation homes**.

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## The best villages to sleep in on the Ile d'Oléron ?

On the Ile d'Oléron, things to see and do are spread out all over the island. We therefore advise you to choose **central accommodation** so that you can get to the various points of interest easily.

In summer, we advise you to use the cycle paths to get around more easily.

In our opinion, the best place to stay is on the **coast near La Cotinière**, where you'll have easy access to one of the great beaches of the Côte Sauvage, and you'll be able to take advantage of the many night-time activities in high season.

If you really want to be at the center of Oléronaise life, we recommend the village of **Saint-Pierre d'Oléron** or **Dolus-d'Oléron**, where you can enjoy the many restaurants and markets while being only a few kilometers from the beaches.

### 1. La Cotinière: a hotel by the sea

La **Cotinière** is a charming fishing port on the west coast of the Ile d'Oléron. It's one of the island's most **lively tourist** villages, with a market held every day in season. Many restaurants and bars opposite the port are open in summer. We fell in love with its small **fishing port**.

It's also a strategic location for visiting **the island by bike**, as many cycle paths cross La Cotinière.

To make the most of this village, without being disturbed by the crowds and noise, we recommend you **stay to the south of the village**, close to the coast, where

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you'll have easy access to one of the great beaches of the wild coast.

With ocean and pool view

The hotel is ideally located, with **ocean** access and **just a few minutes' walk from the lively fishing port** of La Cotinière. Free parking + breakfast. In short, go for it!

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## 2. Vert-Bois: a waterfront address

We have a real weakness for the [Hôtel le Vert Bois](#) especially because it's just a stone's throw from **our favorite beach on the Ile d'Oléron: Plage de Vert-Bois**. Calm, wild and lined with pine trees, it's the perfect place to relax away from the hustle and bustle.

The hotel is simple, friendly, surrounded by nature, and superbly placed for exploring the south and west of the island by bike. It offers **double and family** rooms with a superb swimming pool.

After a day on the beach or out for a stroll, you'll really appreciate the comfort and tranquility of the premises. A no-fuss address, ideal for a rejuvenating vacation with your feet in the Atlantic.

### **3. On the coast near Château d'Oléron: a campsite with its feet in the water**

The ideal place to stay on the island of Oleron is as close as possible to the ocean. We've listed [our favorite beaches in an article you can read here](#).

You can choose between beaches facing the **Atlantic Ocean** (west side), which are more exposed to the wind, or beaches **facing the mainland** (east side), which are more family-friendly and quieter, with beautiful views of Fort Boyard, the Ile de Ré and La Rochelle.

Numerous campsites are located on the oyster route, just a few kilometers from Château d'Oléron (accessible via the cycle path) and facing the Atlantic Ocean, making them an excellent option for a stay on the island.

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Nos conseils et hébergements

[Camping Ostrea](#): a **family-run campsite**, located in the south of the island on **the Route des Huîtres** (one of our favorite coastal roads in Oléron) and next to the **colorful cabanes de la Baudissière** (where we buy our Chez Mamelou oysters). An ideal location for easy access between **the south and the center of Oléron**, without spending too much time in the car.

This campsite has a lovely swimming pool (covered & heated in mid-season). An ideal family campsite. Types of accommodation: mobile homes, cottages and ecolodges for 4 to 8 people with superb new facilities.

Little extras: bike path at the foot of the campsite (3.5km from Château d'Oléron and Zorba's guiguette), pétanque court with sea view & great team.

#### 4. Saint-Pierre d'Oléron: a hotel in the historic center

The dynamic **Saint-Pierre-d'Oléron** is located in the center of the island. It's one of the liveliest cities in the off-season.

You can stroll through its historic center and narrow streets without missing **Pierre Loti's** house.

If it rains during your stay, this is where you'll find the **cinema**, the **Ile d'Oléron museum** and a **great media library**, with a comfortable children's area and a great section of comics and travel books (obviously, this is a section we know well.). There's plenty of entertainment for children, often free of charge.

In the heart of the city

[Hôtel Le Square](#) in **Saint-Pierre-d'Oléron** is an excellent option if you want to

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enjoy the center of Saint-Pierre-d'Oléron and its small restaurants. The hotel is nicely decorated and equipped with a heated pool. Public parking and breakfast.

## **5. In Saint Georges d'Oléron: L'Anse des Pins campsite \*\*\*\*: for families**

This [family-run campsite](#), located west of **Saint-Georges-d'Oléron** in the north of the island, offers easy access to the north of the island.

It **overlooks the ocean**, which you can enjoy on some of the pitches. This campsite has beautiful indoor and outdoor pools, with waterslides, a paddling pool and a pirate structure. The beautiful sandy beach of **Domino** is just 500 metres away on foot. An ideal waterfront family campsite! He has an excellent reputation.

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## 6. In Saint-Trojan: a hotel with a sea view

**Saint Trojan Les Bains** is the small seaside town **to the south of the island, close to the viaduct** .

In **Saint-Trojan-les-Bains**, don't miss the harbor, lined with little wooden huts hosting designers and restaurants. **Saint Trojan** beach on the west side and the wave-sheltered **Gatseau beach** (south of the village) are two very beautiful beaches.

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the ocean. The rooms are magnificent and some have a sea view. The hotel restaurant is also one of the best on the island.
