The park is home to a number of sculptures and monuments, including the impressive **Arco della Pace** (Arch of Peace) at its northern end. This arch, completed in the early 19th century, symbolizes peace between the European nations after Napoleon.

Parco Sempione is also a place where Milanese socialize. On weekends and summer evenings, it transforms into a lively gathering place, where families, sports enthusiasts and groups of friends come together to enjoy the outdoor setting. It's also a great place for travelers to relax, offering a well-deserved break after a day of sightseeing in the city.

- **Arco della Pace:** As mentioned above, this majestic arch is a must-see. Its history and neoclassical architecture make it a historical and artistic landmark.
- **Torre Branca:** This steel tower, designed by Gio Ponti in 1933, offers a

breathtaking panoramic view of Milan. Climbing to its summit is a not-to-be-missed experience for lovers of urban views.

- **Arena Civica:** Built in the early 19th century, this arena is a magnificent example of neoclassical architecture. Today, it serves as a venue for sporting and cultural events.
- **Palazzo dell'Arte:** Home to the **Triennale di Milano**, this building is a leading center for art and design, offering interesting exhibitions throughout the year.

This park is ideal for a short nature walk during your city escapade, or for a siesta or picnic after a visit to the château.

Our tips for organizing: price, location,

schedule...

Best times to visit: The Sforza Castle is accessible all year round, but spring and autumn offer pleasant weather and less dense crowds. Early mornings are ideal to avoid the crowds.

How to get there: Located in the center of Milan, the castle is easily accessible by public transport, notably via the red metro line (Cairoli Castello stop).

Preparatory tips for the tour: We recommend wearing comfortable shoes, as the tour involves a lot of walking. Remember also to check current opening times and any temporary closures before your visit.

Buy your tickets in advance: whether you wish to take the tour on your own or with a guide, we strongly recommend that you buy your tickets in advance to avoid waiting at the entrance and to be able to choose your time slot for the tour.

Our opinion

We recommend a stroll through the beautiful **Sempione Park** and admire the castle's exterior facades. As far as museums are concerned, there's a lot to see. If you're in a hurry, we advise you to concentrate on just one museum.
